



### Leaving a Legacy to Hopton Rehab & Homing Centre

If you're considering helping our horses & ponies by leaving a gift to HRH in your Will, it's important to understand that legacies to charities come in several different forms, for example:

A residuary legacy will leave HRH a share or the whole of your estate after your other wishes and expenses have been met. It ensures your family are provided for first, and your gift may grow over time as the value of your estate increases.

A pecuniary legacy is the gift of a specific amount of money. By leaving a pecuniary legacy to HRH you can fix an amount in your Will, but its value may be reduced over the years by inflation.

A specific legacy is the gift of a physical item or items in your Will to HRH, for example property or jewellery.

Whichever you choose, you know that you will be helping horses & ponies at HRH and we thank you.

Here is some suggested wording which you might wish to take to your solicitor:-

#### Residual Legacy

"I give the whole of my estate (or x% of the residue of my estate) to HRH for Animals of Hopton Rehab & Homing Centre, Charity Registration No. 1173847 for it's general charitable purposes and I declare that the receipt of a Trustee or other proper officer of the HRH Charity shall be a full and sufficient discharge for the said legacy."

#### Pecuniary Legacy

"I give the sum of £x to Hopton Rehab & Homing Centre, Charity Registration No. 1173847 for it's general charitable purposes and I declare that the receipt of the Trustee or other proper officer of the HRH Charity shall be a full and sufficient discharge for the said legacy".

#### For a Specific Item/Gift

"I give my (description of gift) to Hopton Rehab & Homing Centre, Charity Registration No. 1173847 for it's general charitable purposes and I direct that the receipt of the Trustee or other proper officer of the HRH Charity shall be a full and sufficient discharge for the said legacy.
